## DELIVERING FOR YOU, IN OUR FIRST 100 DAYS!

### BACK IN PARLIAMENT

Last month, Parliament returned and our Government quickly got to work on COVID-19 supports, LGBTQ2+ rights, health protections, and repealing mandatory minimum sentences. I am busy meeting with colleagues, advocates, and constituents about the legislation we are putting forward.

While I most enjoy speaking with constituents in the riding, I know that my time in Ottawa is translating into strong, ambitious action that is delivering the promises we made in the summer.

I sit on the Natural Resources committee, where I am working with colleagues to reach our climate goals, while creating good-paying clean jobs.

I am in the riding for January before heading back to Ottawa in February.

### OUR FIRST 100 DAYS

November and December were busy. We quickly tabled four bills:

- C-2 provides targeted COVID-19 supports to businesses that are still experiencing losses, and to individuals subject to new lockdowns.
- C-3 provides protections to those accessing healthcare from intimidation and 10 days of paid sick leave to federally-regulated workers.
- C-4 completely bans conversion therapy and was passed unanimously by all parties.
- C-5 repeals some mandatory minimum sentences to address systemic racism and takes a harm reduction approach to drug

# Our First 100 Days

## C-2, TARGETED COVID-19 SUPPORTS

In December we legislated targeted COVID-19 supports including three new targeted wage and rent subsidy programs for the hardest hit businesses. We are also introducing a new-targeted benefit, to provide income support to workers whose employment is interrupted by government-imposed public health lockdowns.

## C-3, PROTECTING HEALTHCARE WORKERS

We introduced protections for healthcare workers and those seeking health services to ensure workers are not obstructed from safely accessing their workplace and are protected against intimidation and threats both in-person and online. We also introduced 10 days of sick leave for federally-regulated workers.

## C-4, BANNING CONVERSION THERAPY

We unanimously passed a complete ban on conversion therapy in December. This ban provides protection and strengthens the rights of equality and dignity in the LGBTQ2+ community. We are committed to ensuring that everyone—regardless of their gender expression, identity, or sexual orientation—can live equally and freely.
