RESTORE POSITIVE & INCLUSIVE POLITICS

We will bring back positive, progressive, and inclusive politics starting with convening a Fairness, Diversity, and Inclusion Council to create solutions that reduce inequality in our community. FIGHT FOR OUR AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

Fight for the needs of our farmers and agricultural sector. I will convene an Agricultural Advisory Council of farmers and other agricultural industry partners to advise me on policy and legislative changes that support strong and sustainable agriculture in Cloverdale—Langley City.

IMPLEMENT \$10 A DAY CHILD CARE

We will reduce fees for child care by 50% in the next year and deliver \$10 a day child care within five years or less. Through this process, we will build 250,000 new high-quality child care spaces and hire 40,000 more early childhood educators. This will save the average family in our community about \$10,000 per child annually.

SUPPORT THE PERFORMING ARTS

Support the Performing Arts in Cloverdale—Langley City. Secure federal support for accessible, sustainable spaces where the people of Cloverdale—Langley City can celebrate and experience our vibrant performing arts community.
