A MESSAGE FROM YOUR MP

I hope everyone had a great summer in Cloverdale—Langley City. My time in the riding this summer has been spent in meetings and community events. It was great getting the chance to see some familiar faces and meet many new ones as well.

This summer, I had the pleasure of hosting two Seniors' Town Halls in June and August. These Town Halls gave me the opportunity to sit down with seniors in the riding and talk about what I can do to better represent and support them. I also sat down with several religious leaders during a roundtable in July, something I aim to do every three months. Key issues we discussed included housing, homelessness, mental health and addictions, immigration and refugees, and concerns around cost of living. Thank you to everyone who showed up to these events and letting me know what I can do to better support the people of Cloverdale—Langley City.

In March of this year, the Cloverdale Cenotaph was vandalized, with the "Kneeling in Remembrance" soldier pushed off the cenotaph. Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC) funded \$7,700 to restore the Cloverdale Cenotaph, with the soldier returning to his post on August 19th. I visited the Cloverdale Cenotaph with Minister Petitpas Taylor and City of Surrey Mayor Brenda Locke. I am grateful to VAC for its assistance in restoring "Kneeling in Remembrance", providing us with a meeting place to honour those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in servicing Canada.

CANADA SUMMER JOBS 2023

This year, 48 employers in Cloverdale—Langley City participated in CSJ, which provided 179 jobs to youth and brought \$682,397 in funding into the riding.
